

NARCIS.nl: the gateway to online scholarly information

NARCIS.nl is the national portal for anyone looking for information about researchers and their work in the Netherlands. Besides researchers and policy makers, NARCIS is also used by students, journalists and education, government and business professionals.

NARCIS (National Academic Research and Collaborations Information System) offers you access to the huge collection of the publication repositories of the Dutch universities, the Dutch Academy KNAW, research funding organisation NWO and a number of research institutes, supplemented by research data from several data archives and descriptions of research projects, researchers and research institutes.

Personal information in NARCIS

Are you trying to find a researcher in a specific discipline? In NARCIS you will not have trouble finding the right person. A personal profile page offers the researcher's contact details as well as an overview of research projects, (open access) publications and datasets. For many researchers a Digital Author Identifier (DAI) and International Standard Name Identifier (ISNI) is included.

For the researcher it is possible to add an ORCID identifier as well. These unique personal numbers ensure that the right person is always referred to when information is reused or cited.

Scholarly information in NARCIS

In NARCIS you will find the metadata of publications from the Dutch universities, Dutch Academy KNAW, funding organisation NWO and other research institutes, as well as datasets originating from DANS and other data archives. Many publications are open access and can be accessed and (re)used immediately. Also a part of the datasets is open access available. All bibliographical details can be exported directly from NARCIS to EndNote, RefWorks and Mendeley.



The content of NARCIS in graphs

The content of NARCIS is visually represented in charts. For example, in the chart below you find the numbers of all open and closed access publications (articles, theses, books, reports, etc.) available in NARCIS, since 2000. Also a chart with the number of open and closed-access peer reviewed articles is online available.



Using QR codes

All individual researchers and research institutes have their own QR code in NARCIS. Researchers can include their QR codes in journals or print them on a poster, for example. Scanning the code gives access to the corresponding NARCIS webpage with an overview of contact details, publications and research activities.

Do you want to submit your expertise into NARCIS?

You can report your expertise after logging into NARCIS. If you have a personal page in NARCIS, you may update your data and add expertise. If you don't have an individual page in NARCIS, please register first. Within a few days you will receive an e-mail with a link to your personal information. Then you can add new expertise and personal data.

Do you want to stay up to date?

After each search NARCIS offers you an RSS feed to keep you up to date with the latest (open access) publications, datasets and research projects in your field of interest. NARCIS also has a widget enabling you to dynamically post your search results on your blog or website.

Close collaboration

The content of NARCIS is the responsibility of DANS in close collaboration with the universities, [KNAW](#), [NWO](#) and other research institutes.
